

# I-75 Commercial Vehicle Lanes

## What is the Project?

The I-75 Commercial Vehicle Lanes Project will improve mobility and safety for freight operators and passenger vehicles. The project consists of two barrier-separated commercial vehicle-only lanes along I-75 from approximately the I-475/I-75 Interchange near Macon to the McDonough area. The project will benefit all motorists by reducing congestion and improving safety while offering direct economic benefits to travelers in Georgia as well as freight and logistic carriers in the Southeast.

## 5 Things You Need to Know

1. Adds new lane miles on I-75 from the Macon area to the McDonough area
2. This project provides a commercial vehicle travel-only lane, which keeps the general purpose lanes open for typical motorists
3. Projected to reduce delay on I-75 by 40% in 2030\*
4. Reduces maintenance costs on general purpose lanes
5. One of the large-scale Major Mobility Investment Program projects to improve transportation in Georgia

## What's the Project Status?

The project is in the project development phase to evaluate project limits, develop design standards, identify environmentally-sensitive areas, study existing and future freight and passenger traffic patterns, and identify potential access locations. This phase will result in a concept document. The schedule is subject to change.

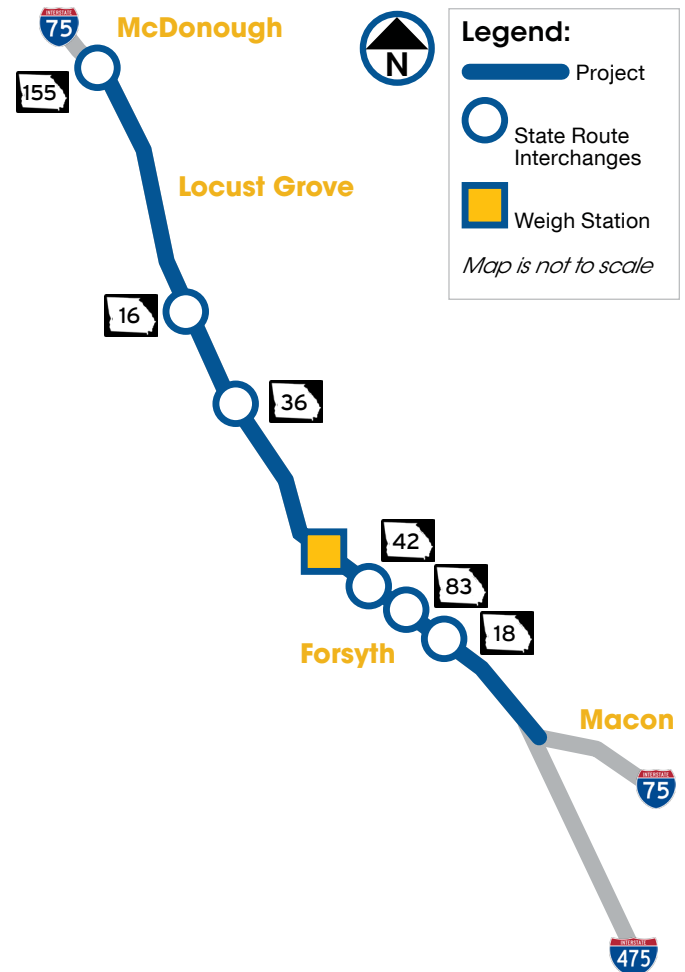
