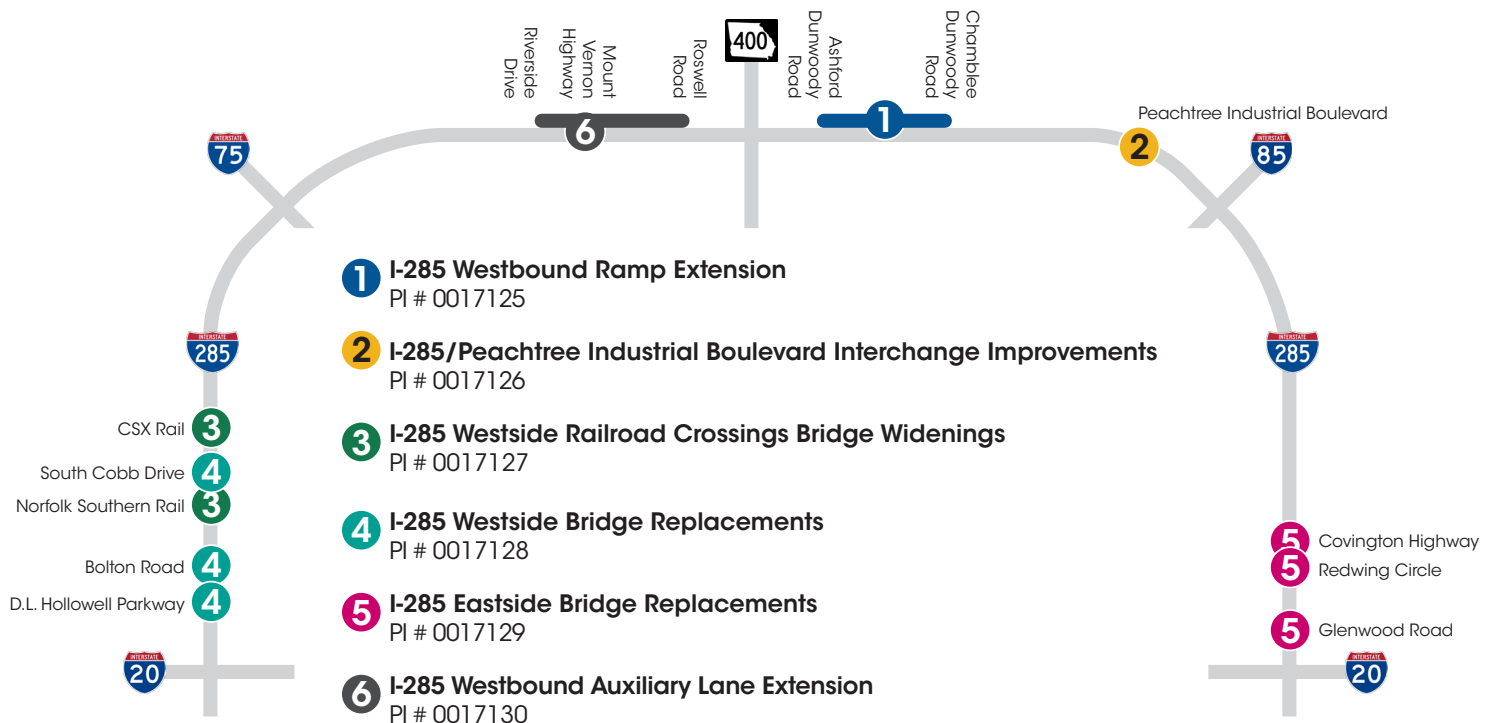


# I-285 Advanced Improvement Projects

## Where are the Projects?



## What are the Projects?

- **I-285 Westbound Ramp Extension (PI # 0017125):** Extends the ramp from Chamblee Dunwoody Road to Ashford Dunwoody Road built under the Transform 285/400 Interchange Improvement project and replaces the Chamblee Dunwoody Road bridge allowing improvements and traffic congestion alleviation sooner.
- **I-285/Peachtree Industrial Boulevard Interchange (PI # 0017126):** Combines the I-285 Westbound exit ramps to Peachtree Industrial Boulevard north and south, while adjusting the horizontal curve of the north exit ramp to reduce bottleneck from I-285.
- **I-285 Westside Railroad Crossings Bridge Widening (PI # 0017127):** Advanced bridge work to accommodate the future express lanes and minimize schedule impact risks associated with railroad coordination.
- **I-285 Westside Bridge Replacements (PI # 0017128):** Provides local road improvements in advance of larger project construction to keep traffic moving during express lanes project construction.
- **I-285 Eastside Bridge Replacements (PI # 0017129):** Provides local road improvements in advance of larger project construction to keep traffic moving during express lanes project construction.
- **I-285 Westbound Auxiliary Lane Extension (PI # 0017130):** Extends auxiliary lane between Roswell Road and Riverside Drive as well as reconstructs the Mount Vernon Highway bridge over I-285, which will provide relief between Transform 285/400 Interchange Improvement project construction and I-285 Top End West Express Lanes construction. This project will allow better maintenance of traffic during the construction of the future express lanes.

The Georgia Department of Transportation (Georgia DOT) continues to advance much-needed, large-scale Major Mobility Investment Program (MMIP) projects. Advancing the design for these projects along I-285 has provided opportunities to implement some project components early bringing improvements to residents, businesses, and motorists sooner.

## What's Next?

These projects are currently early in the preliminary engineering, environmental, and design stages. The schedules are subject to change.
